This four year program offers the student an opportunity to explore allied health and biomedical sciences as they relate to post-secondary study and careers in the medical and health sciences.

The Allied Health major offers a rigorous, comprehensive curriculum in advanced science courses including Anatomy and Physiology, Advanced Chemistry and Physics. In addition, students will be offered courses in nutrition, legal and ethical issues in health care, emergency and clinical care and medical terminology. Students will have the opportunity to have a clinical experience at each grade level. The clinical experience component of this curriculum will allow students to integrate theoretical knowledge with practical application. Moreover, students will participate in a mentored project where research will be combined with experimentation, data analysis and presentation.

The Biomedical Sciences major offers advanced science courses including Anatomy and Physiology, Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Students will be offered courses in principles of biomedical science, human body systems, medical intervention and scientific research. The Biomedical Science curriculum offers students the opportunity to explore the importance of conducting research and data analysis in the medical sciences. The goal of the program is to provide rigorous and relevant curriculum that is project and problem-based in order to engage and prepare high school students for the post-secondary education and training necessary for success in the wide variety of careers associated with the biomedical sciences.
