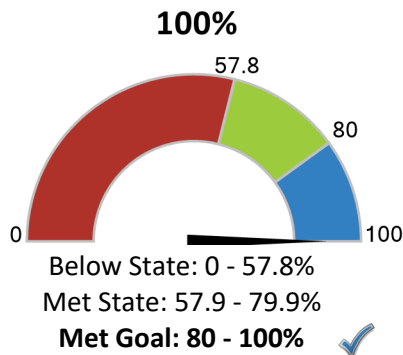
## School Highlights Reported by the District

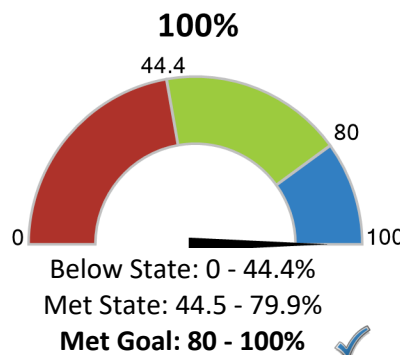

#### English Language Arts



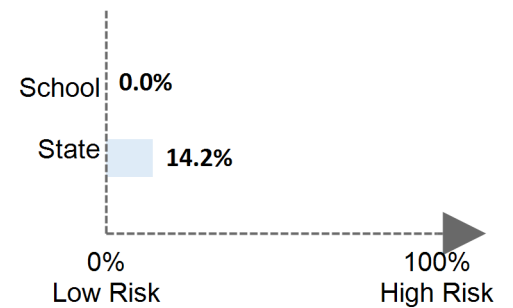
#### Math



### Are students at risk?

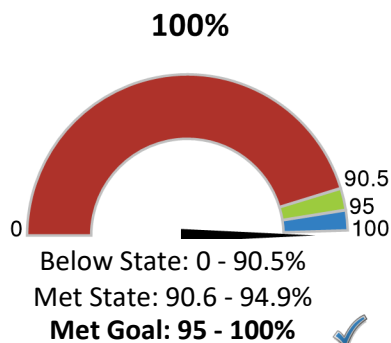
Students that were absent for 10% or more of days enrolled
